Jayne Demore was removed on March 3, 2019, after voter list was created.

Vera Dalton is not deceased, she is living at the Hill Haven Nursing Home.

Bobby Joe Caudell, Betty Ayers, and Mary Williams have all been cancelled as deceased, at the time of death the paperwork was not provided as ask for by the deceased persons families or administrators, we now have obtained the necessary paperwork from other sources and have completed the process.

Beverly Smith, Kenneth Smith, J Keith Gowder, Kristin Beasley, David Bray, Patti Bray, Randall Morgan, Kirsten Diehl, and Kyle Diehl, the board did not have sufficient evidence to remove the voters at this time, so letters and confirmation notices will be sent to get information from the voters to update their information. If updated information is received and the voter remains in Banks County, they will vote provisional per Judge Sweats' Order.

Mary Slaton has moved out of state and has been cancelled as a voter in Banks County.

Matthew Moon has moved within the county a voter registration application has been sent to the voter so we can update his address. Per Judge Sweats' order he can vote provisional.

Cindy Lowe, Jarret Lowe, Matthew Lowe, Brenda Parnican, Jennifer Griffin, William Griffin, all have address that are in Banks County, and will remain eligible to vote, per Judge Sweats' order they will vote provisional.
