# NEWS RELEASE Friday March 27, 2020 FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE First Confirmed COVID-19 Case in Habersham County

Habersham County's first confirmed case of COVID-19 was reported by the Georgia Department of Public Health (DPH) in its 12:00 noon report update today. This patient is not currently hospitalized at Habersham Medical Center (HMC) and was not tested through Habersham Medical Center. HMC is prepared to receive positive cases but, to date, there have been no positive test results for COVID-19 at HMC. There have been 21 COVID-19 tests performed at HMC to date, 18 have been negative and 3 are waiting for results.

The Habersham County Board of Commissioners will hold an emergency called meeting on Saturday March 28, 2020 at 9:00 a.m. Information regarding this meeting is attached. We anticipate the Commission will approve a local State of Emergency Declaration and additional directives to provide guidance for the safety and well-being of Habersham County citizens. We strongly urge the citizens of Habersham County to shelter in place and adhere to CDC and DPH guidelines.

We would like to assure the citizens of Habersham that the County, Habersham Medical Center, and our first responders are in constant communication. Our emergency management teams have been meeting regularly in anticipation that COVID-19 would eventually come to Habersham County and preparations have been ongoing for several weeks to respond to cases of COVID-19 once they emerged. Habersham County government, the Emergency Services Department, Sheriff's Department, and Habersham Medical Center have all been preparing diligently to ensure an effective response to cases of COVID-19.

Numerous specific directives have been issued by the governor, DPH, and CDC for many weeks. Citizens should wash their hands regularly and practice social distancing. If anyone feels they have symptoms of COVID-19, they should contact their physician. For up to date information regarding Habersham County and COVID-19, please visit www.habershamga.com.
