TOWN OF ALTO QUALIFICATIONS FOR CANDIDATES

August 01, 2022 - August 05, 2022

- 1. All persons must be of **sound mind** and fit to discharge the duties of the office to which they are chosen or elected <u>O.C.G.A.</u> 45-2-1(5)
- 2. All persons must be **registered to vote**. Ga. Constitution, Article II, Section II, Para. III.
- 3. All persons must be **21 years of age**. O.C.G.A. 45-2-1(1).
- 4. No person shall be eligible to hold office who has been **convicted and sentenced** of a felony involving **moral turpitude** under the laws of this or any other state when the offense is also a felony in this state, unless that person's civil rights have been restored and at least 10 years have elapsed from the date of the completion of the sentence without a subsequent conviction of another felony involving moral turpitude. Ga. Constitution, Article II, Section II, Para. III, and O.C.G.A. 45-2-1(3).
- 5. <u>Federal employees</u> are <u>prohibited</u> from election to public office, except the postmaster or officers and enlisted persons in the military. <u>O.C.G.A.</u> 45-2-1(4).
- 6. Any Town Charter requirements. (Must be qualified to vote for members of the General Assembly of Georgia).
- 7. The residency requirement for a <u>candidate</u> for any municipal office, except (a) offices of judicial nature, or (b) alderman, shall be <u>12 months residency</u> within the municipality prior to the date of election. <u>O.C.G.A.</u> 45-2-1(1).
- 8. Persons meeting the above qualifications shall <u>file a "Notice of Candidacy"</u> in the Habersham County Elections & Registration Office (located at 130 Jacob's Way, Suite 101, Clarkesville, Georgia 30523) during qualifying week. Qualifying for the November 8, 2022 Special Election is August 01, 2022 August 05, 2021 from 8:30 a.m. 4:30 p.m., Monday Thursday and 8:30 a.m. Noon on Friday, (except for a one-hour lunch break) Georgia Municipal Election Code 21-3-91(e).
- 9. A qualifying fee for the office of Council Member is \$35.00, to be elected by the qualified voters of the Town of Alto. Georgia. Municipal Code 21-3-90(a). (Cash payments NOT accepted. ONLY checks or money orders are accepted; make payable to Habersham County Commissioners.)

The Seats Up for the November 8, 2022 Special Election are as follows:

Council Member, Post 1, seat formerly held by Turner Griffith **Council Member, Post 5,** seat formerly held by P. J. Huggins

Said Seats are for a remainder term of approximately three (3) years, one (1) month and sixteen (16) days, beginning on or around November 15, 2022 through December 31, 2025.
