## A Proclamation Declaring April 9, 2023 – April 15, 2023 as Public Safety Telecommunications Week in Habersham County

**WHEREAS**, Communications Officers are the first and most critical contact for our citizens with emergency services; and

**WHEREAS**, Communications Officers are a vital link for our police officers, firefighters, and first responders in monitoring their activities by radio, providing them with information, and ensuring their safety; and

**WHEREAS**, Communications Officers have contributed substantially to the apprehension of criminals, suppression of fires, and treatment of patients; and

**WHEREAS**, Communications Officers exhibit compassion, understanding, and professionalism while performing their duties.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED**, the Habersham County Commission duly assembled this 20<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2023, does hereby proclaim April 9<sup>th</sup> through April 15, 2023 as “PUBLIC SAFETY TELECOMMUNICATIONS WEEK IN HABERSHAM COUNTY”, in honor of the men and women whose diligence and professionalism keep our community and citizens safe.
